Any usage other than that mentioned in these instructions is inappropriate; the manufacturer disclaims liability for any resulting damages. In such cases the user assumes responsibility for all risk.

There is considerable risk involved in improperly constructing, setting up and using the retracting compression spring columns that are under compression. Therefore it is compulsory to adhere to all safety requirements in this assembly guide and instruction manual. You are thereby providing for your safety as well as the safety of others.

When setting up the table the necessary room and safety distances to adjacent parts/furnishing objects must be observed. As The Klöud is placed among other items, the regulations of trade associations or other supervisory authorities that are in force locally have to be considered.

Children or other persons unable to understand or appreciate the dangers involved are not allowed in the assembly area during construction and set up of the table, which should be conducted by qualified personnel.

This equipment is not intended for use by persons, including children, with limited physical or mental capabilities or insufficient experience and/or insufficient knowledge.

The compression spring table is intended for proper use in commercial office and administrative areas.

It must be ensured that the loading on the compression spring table matches the set spring force.

After setting up the table, ensure that this assembly guide is always visible and accessible to other users. If necessary, inform others of their responsibility.



Lifting capacity: maximum weight 154lbs (70kg) including construction above the top frame (table top, desk top accessories, etc.) Alteration of the system in any form is not permitted.

Cleaning recommendations for powder-coated surfaces

For optimal care and cleaning of powder-coated surfaces the recommendations below should be followed:

- Use only a soft cloth or industrial cotton wool. Refrain from rubbing hard.
- Surface and cleaning agent temperatures <25°C. (Do not steam clean surface.)
- Clean stains with a damp soft cloth. Use cold or lukewarm water. Small amounts of neutral or alkaline detergent additives may be used if necessary.
- Do not apply detergent for extended periods of time. If necessary repeat cleaning process after 24 hours. Wipe with cold water immediately after cleaning. (Use a damp (not wet) cloth.)
- Do not use scratching or abrasive agents.
- Do not use acidic or strongly alkaline detergents.
- Do not use organic solvents which contain ester, ketone, alcohols, aromatic compounds, glycol ether, halogenated hydrocarbons or similar substances.

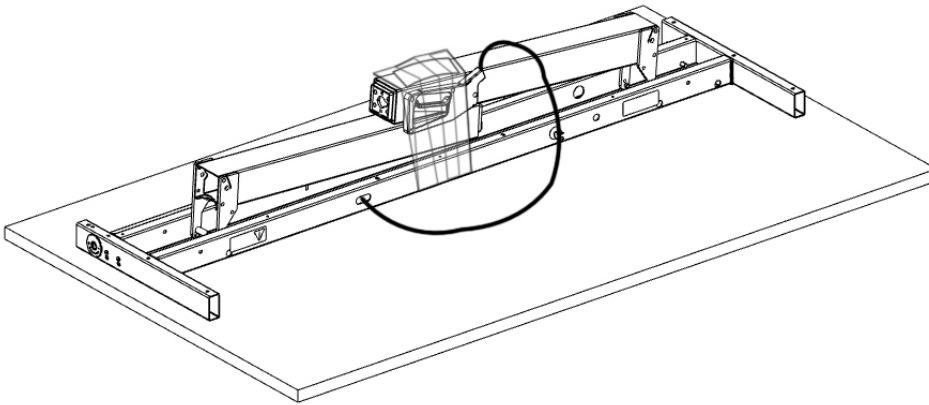
NOTE: Do not lubricate or use cleaning agents on the dry guides in the guide columns. Never use any silicone products as this can lead to squeaking of the guide columns.

	<p>AVOID INJURY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not remove strapping until the base is placed on the work surface risk of pinch point. - Do not activate the release lever before the table is fully assembled and in the upright position. - Table leg column may extend suddenly with great force and speed, which will damage the table and could cause serious injury.

	<p>RISK OF INJURY. Legs extend suddenly.</p> <p>DO NOT remove safety lock pins unless table is fully assembled and in upright position.</p> <p>DO NOT activate release lever unless table is fully assembled and in upright position, or legs are fully extended.</p> <p>READ and follow directions to assemble table.</p> <p>SAVE Pins and RE-INSERT when legs are fully compressed BEFORE transporting table.</p>

- 1** Place work surface on floor. Set table base assembly on top of work surface. Remove packaging wrap once the frame is placed on the work surface

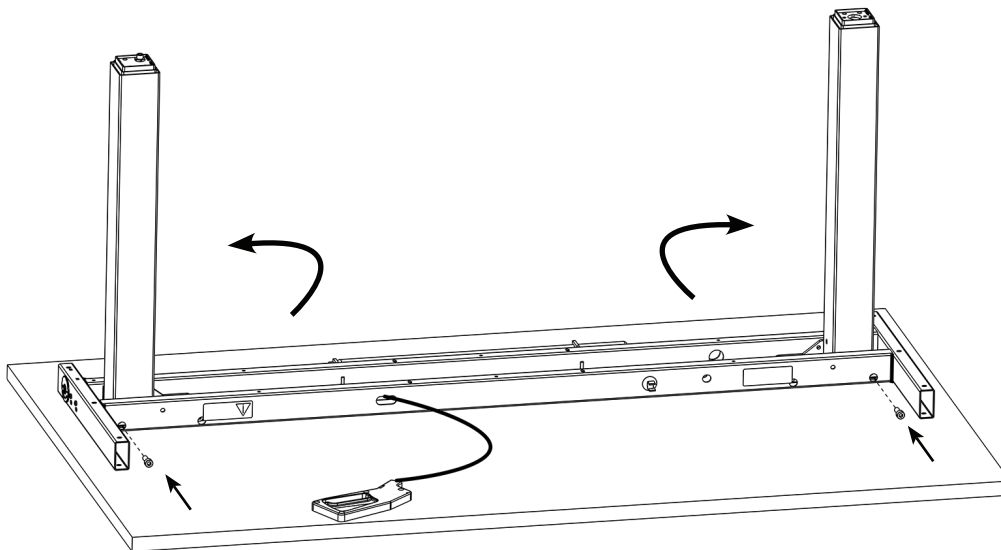


CAUTION: Never activate the manual release before the table is completely assembled and standing properly on the floor. Otherwise there is a safety risk when extending the unloaded columns.

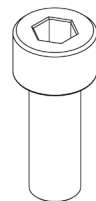


- 2** Lift legs perpendicular to the frame and install front leg bolts (2x).

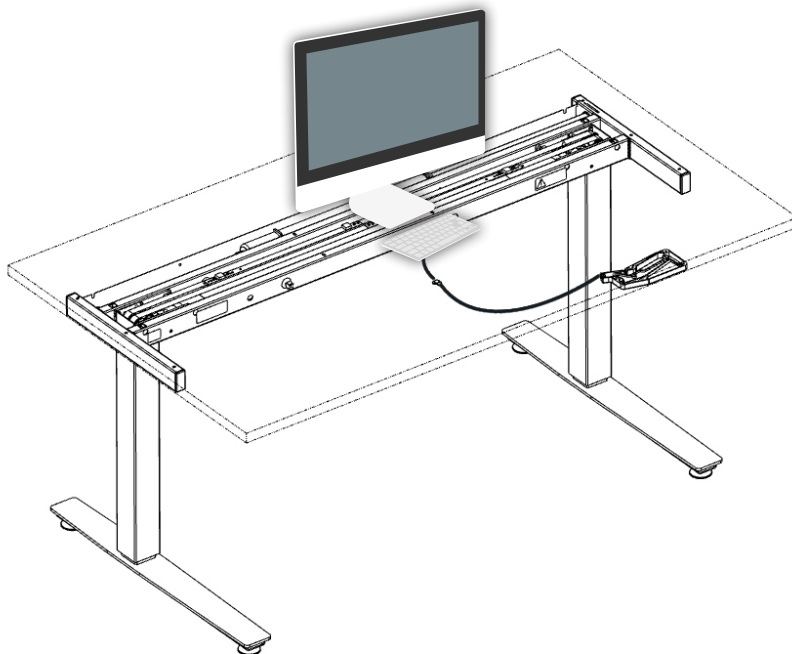

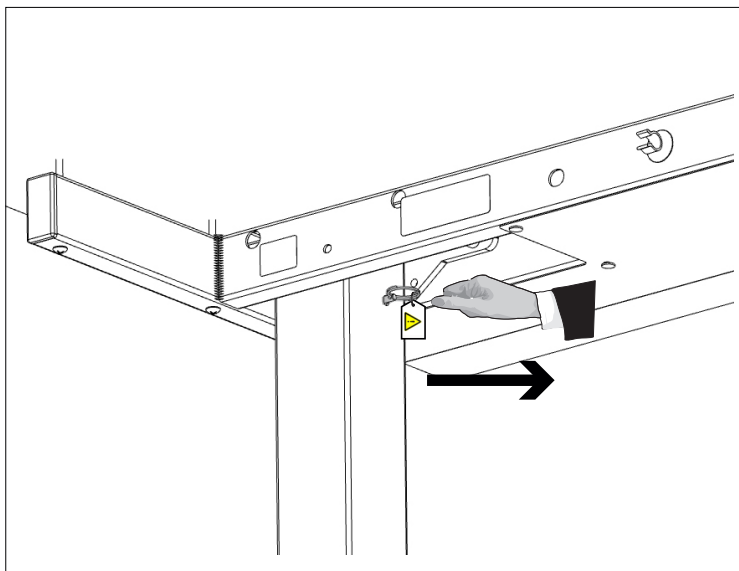
13 Add intended weight load while desk is in fixed position.

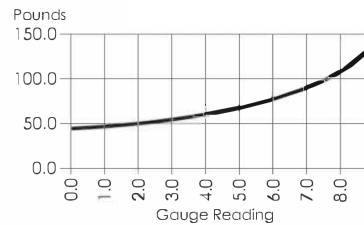
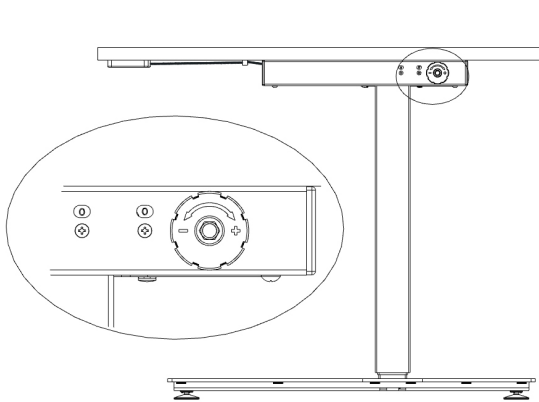
If pin is stuck, apply light downward pressure to the table top.

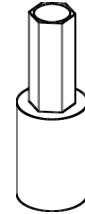
15 Using the ratchet wrench or manual driver with the 10mm hex bit, adjust the pneumatic force by turning the hex adjustment found on the side, next to the gauge.

- See the graph below right for a 48" table base. At the 0/0 gauge reading, weight is set for just under 50 lbs. That moves up slowly to about 60 lbs at the 4/0 gauge reading and then increases more rapidly, to over 100 lbs at the 8/0 gauge reading. **Do not adjust past the 8/0 setting due to risk of damage.**
- If you know the approximate weight of the table top (work surface plus contents), you can go to the gauge reading for that weight.
- The goal in making this adjustment is to equalize the force needed to raise the table with the force needed to lower it. This is important when testing operation.

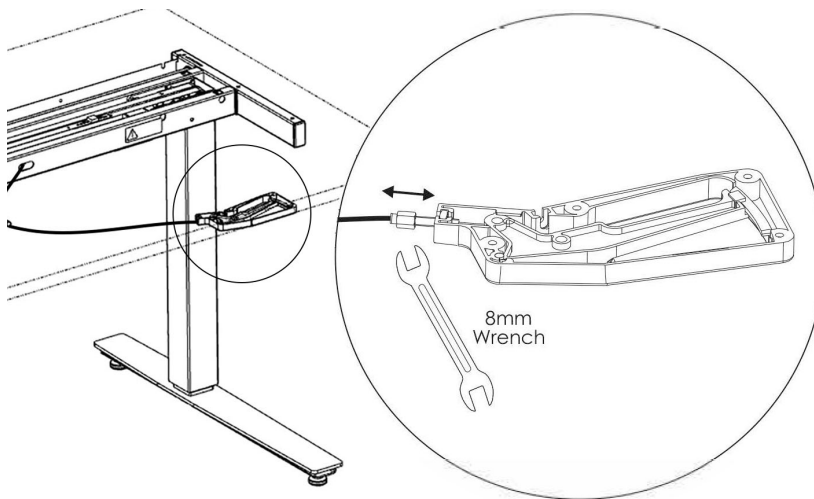

16 Adjust cable tension if necessary.

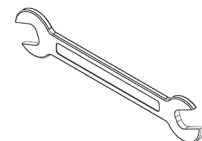
- If the table does not lock into place when the lever is released, tighten the cable adjustment nut one-half turn and recheck.
- If the table stays locked in one place or moves slowly, loosen the cable adjustment nut one-half turn and recheck.



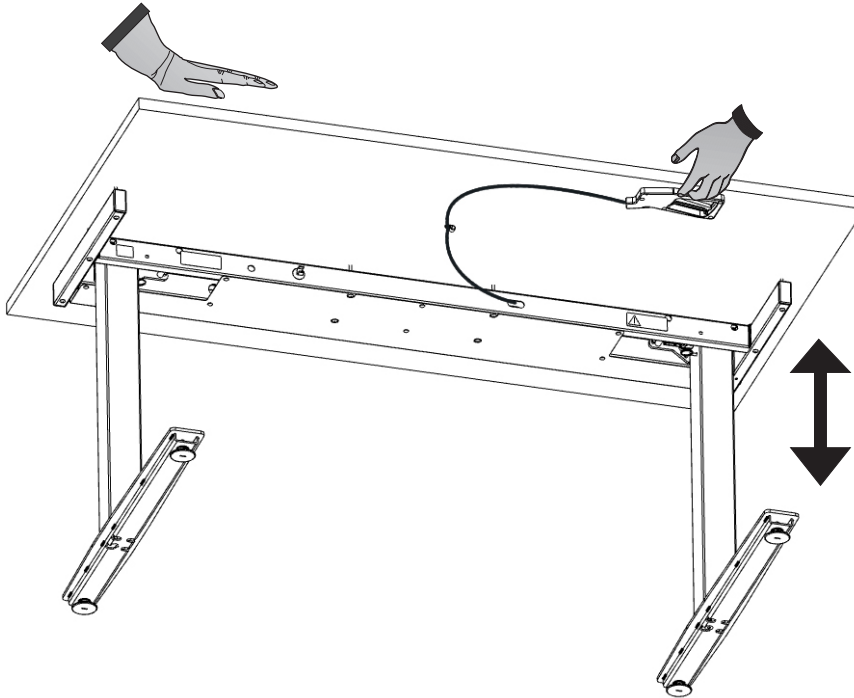
If needed adjust bowden cable. The lever of the hand release should have a little play in a non activated position.

- 17** Lightly press one hand onto the tabletop and activate the lever with the other hand until the table is at the desired height.

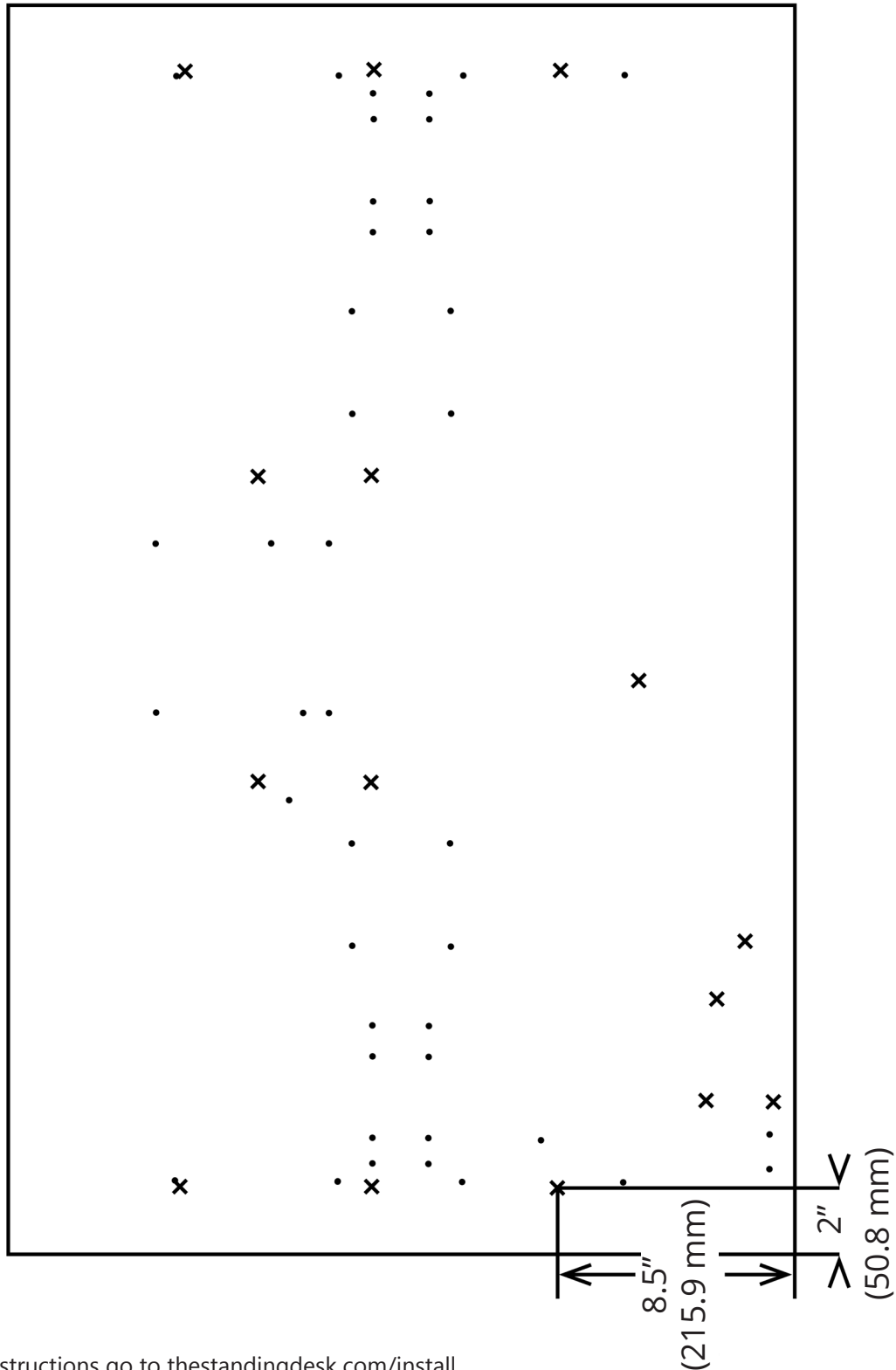

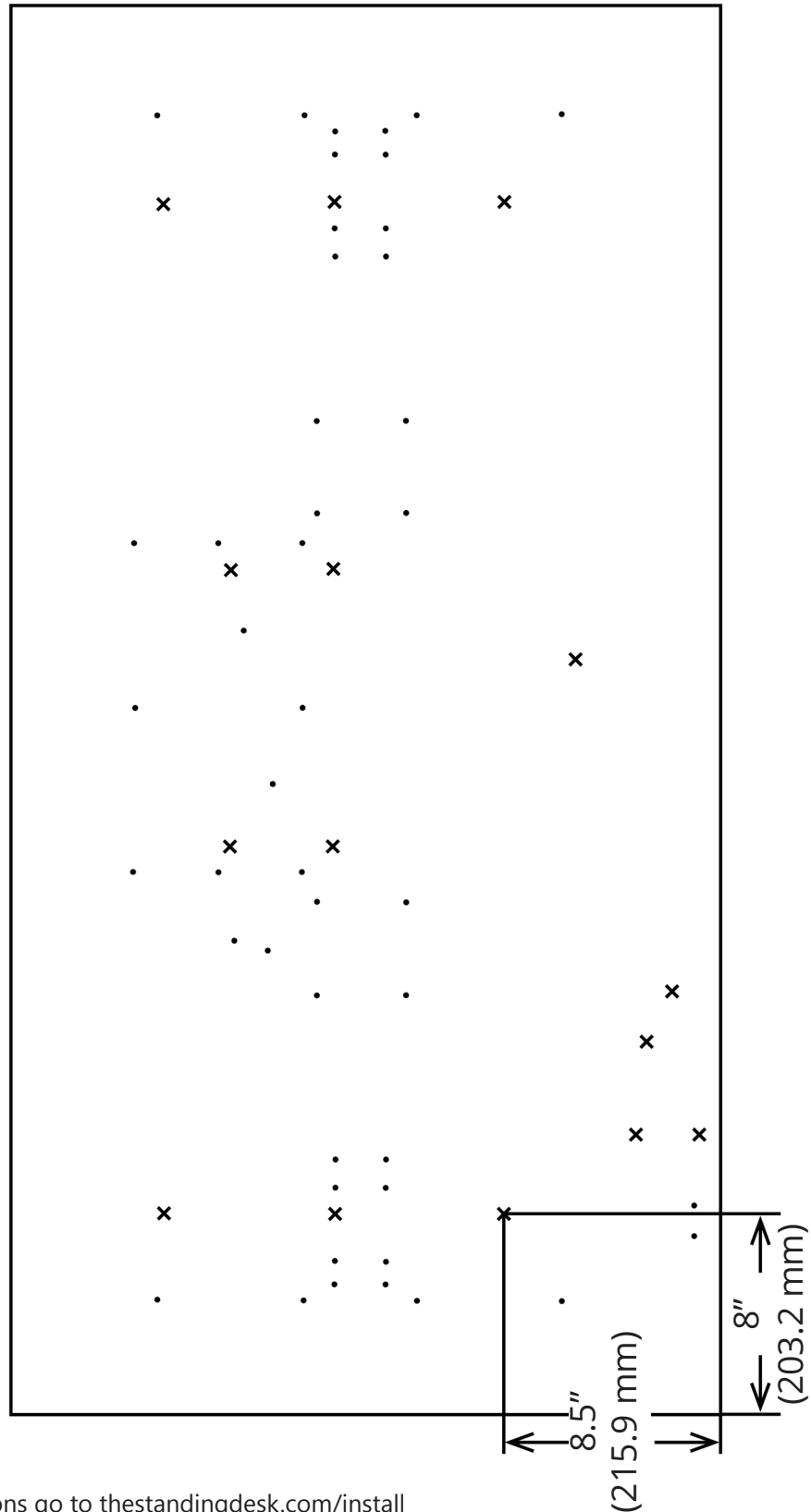

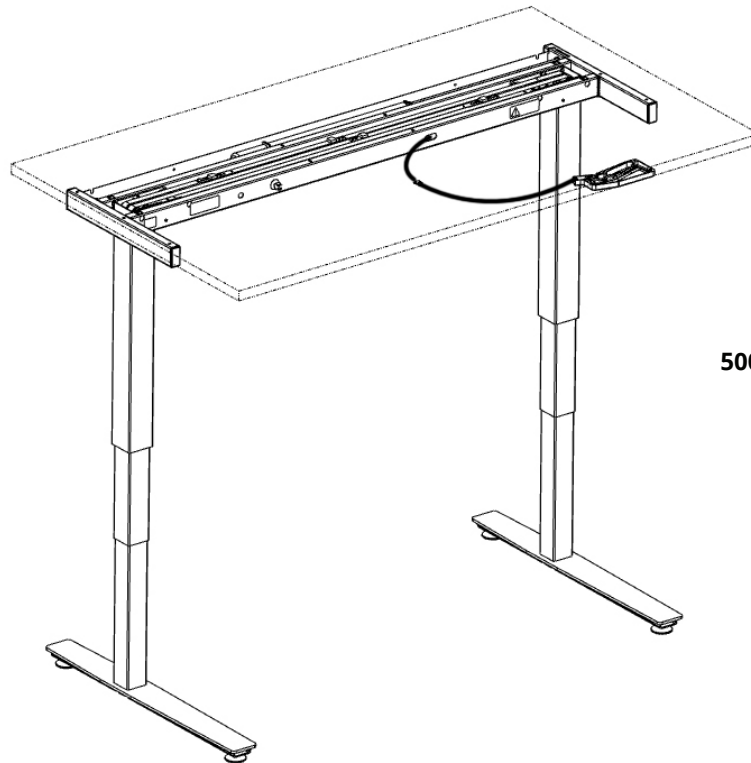
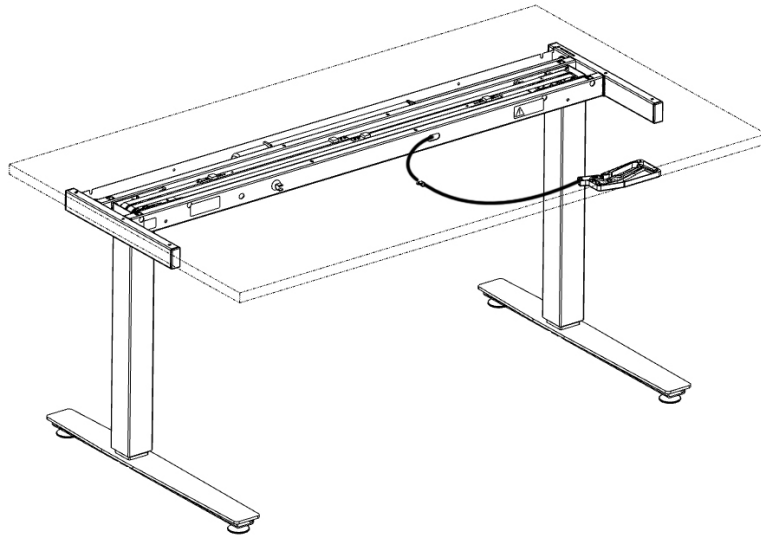
29"x47" Work surface mount hole diagram.
